

Preparations for the development of the Kazakh Graduate School of Materials and Processes (KG MP)

The goal of this application is to carry out preliminaries for establishment of the Kazakh Doctorate School of Materials and Processes within the frameworks of deepening and intensifying the current collaboration between TU Clausthal and EKSTU Ust-Kamenogorsk. The model of structured doctoral programs is focused on more organized training within the frameworks of Doctor's degree integration into the Bologna structure (QFBEHEA) which is utilized in many universities of Europe. Still it is not used in Kazakh system of training doctorate students. This project will provide the opportunity to establish conditions and to set mechanisms for the foundation of the first doctorate school of materials and processes in Kazakhstan through cooperation with TU Clausthal. To achieve this goal the following workpackages should be taken: WP1: Kickoff-meeting for defining requirements of structured doctoral programs and creating a working committee; WP2: to develop the concept for a structured program for doctorate students; WP3: to develop academic infrastructure for KG MP; WP4: to develop measures providing the quality of the Kazakh doctorate school; WP5: to elaborate the application document and apply for funding.
